The app automatically handles all government requirements, as well as many other "Precision Livestock Farming" functions.





Once scanned, the data is recorded and processed in real-time, over the mobile internet (using wifi or 4G). Hence, there is no need to hook the reader up to a PC. The app takes care of it all. When the user makes a mistake, he receives a warning message in the app. When a user cannot resolve the issue, Litams offers a 24/7 (free) support desk.
